


A Verb is a word that shows action or a state of being.








(AV) express physical or mental action.






HOW ARE THE VERBS USED?

LINKING VERBS

A linking verb (LV) is a verb that expresses a state of being. A linking verb connects, or links, the subject to a word or word group that identifies or describes the subject.

LINKING VERBS

is

am has been

have been can be

are had been

should be

was will be

might be

may be

were would have been



The cookie smelled delicious

LV

He smelled the cookie.

AV
